

Grant Funding for Small Businesses and Nonprofits

RENAISSANCE FUND TWO

Waynesboro City Council has allocated an additional \$300,000 in small business grants.

The **RENAISSANCE FUND TWO** is a competitive grant of up to \$25,000 for Waynesboro businesses impacted by business closures due to COVID-19. The program is available to for profit Waynesboro based businesses with fewer than 20 FTE employees.


Grant funds may be used to reimburse the costs of business interruption caused by required closures including PPE, other equipment needed to reopen safely, cleaning, and rent/ mortgage, as well as certain payroli expenses and to cover commercial debt payments. Eligibility criteria and expenses have changed from the original Renaissance Fund so please review the program details carefully.

This is a competitive grant process, with all applications received by the deadline to be reviewed. Successful grantees will be required to submit receipts and other documents for eliable exponses for reimbursement.

Complete program details can be found here. The application form will be available by noon on August 31, 2020 and completed applications are due no later than September 9, 2020 at 9 am.

Waynesboro City Council has allocated \$100,000 for small business grants

The RENAISSANCE FUND is a competitive grant of up to \$10,000 for Waynesboro businesses impacted by business closures due to COVID-19. The program is available to for profit Waynesboro based businesses with fewer than 20 FTE employees that did not receive a PPP forgivable loan or an EIDL Ioan.

Grant funds may be used to reimburse the costs of business interruption caused by required closures including PPE, other equipment needed to reopen safety, cleaning, and rent/mortgage.
